

What is the Drive Smart Bay Area program?

With more than 4.8 million licensed drivers in the San Francisco Bay Area, the Drive Smart Bay Area program is encouraging residents to drive smarter and safer by making small changes to their driving behavior and properly maintaining their vehicles.

What is smart driving?

"Smart driving" refers to a set of strategies that maximize vehicle fuel efficiency by improving driving habits and vehicle performance.

What can I do?

By following simple tips to improve driving habits and vehicle performance, drivers can increase their vehicle's fuel efficiency by up to 15%. They'll save gas and money, increase safety, reduce stress and improve air quality. Smart, right?

As part of the Drive Smart Bay Area program, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is making it even easier to drive smart by offering all Bay Area drivers an Automatic adapter for just \$49.95—that's 50% off the \$99.95 suggested retail price!

How can I participate?

In addition, MTC is offering all registered Bay Area drivers a 50% discount on an Automatic adapter, a state-of-the-art smart driving plug-in tool. Eligible drivers must be registered in the nine-county Bay Area, which includes the following counties:

- Santa Clara
- San Mateo
- San Francisco

What is a smart driving plug-in tool?

The Automatic adapter is a small, smart driving tool that plugs into your car's OBD-II diagnostic port and works like a fitness tracker for your car. By communicating through an app on your smartphone (with additional information available through a web-based dashboard), it will help train you to drive smarter by alerting you to poor driving habits. It also diagnoses engine trouble, reminds you where your car is parked, provides emergency crash response and other helpful features.

MTC is offering a discount on the Automatic adapter while supplies last.

How does the Automatic adapter work?

Automatic plugs into your vehicle's OBD-II port and communicates with your smartphone via Bluetooth. When you install the Automatic app, the adapter will help you:

- Improve your fuel efficiency with gentle audio warnings that help to reduce hard braking, rapid acceleration and over-speeding, the three biggest factors that contribute to lower gas mileage.
- Avoid extra trips to the pump. Subtle adjustments to a commute can make a big impact on your mileage. See the cost and MPG for every trip to find more efficient routes. Tag certain trips for business for easier expense tracking.



- Decode your check engine light like the pros using easyto-understand descriptions provided by the app. Clear the light for minor issues or, if you need an expert, get a list of well-reviewed mechanics nearby.
- In an accident, get immediate assistance from a live agent. Automatic will call emergency services and notify your loved ones. (This service is available 24/7 and doesn't require a subscription fee.)
- Coach your teen driver to be a smarter, safer driver. Make
 the first six months of unsupervised driving safer, less
 stressful and more relaxed for both the parents and teens
 using the License+ app.



What cars does Automatic work with?

Automatic works with almost all gasoline-, diesel- and hybrid-powered vehicles built after 1996. It does not currently work in electric vehicles. To see if your vehicle is compatible, please visit www.automatic.com/cars.

What smartphones does Automatic work with?

You must own a smartphone to operate an Automatic adapter. Compatible smartphones and operating systems include:

- iPhone 5, 5c, 5s, 6 and 6 Plus
- iOS 7 and above
- Android 4.0 Ice Cream Sandwich and above (for most phones)
- Android 4.3+ Jelly Bean (for HTC One)

BLU Advance 4.0, BLU Dash 5.0 and BLU Life Play S are not currently compatible.

What other restrictions apply?

You must be a registered Bay Area resident to participate. Max two adapters per household. This offer is not valid with other promotions and ends on June 11, 2016.
